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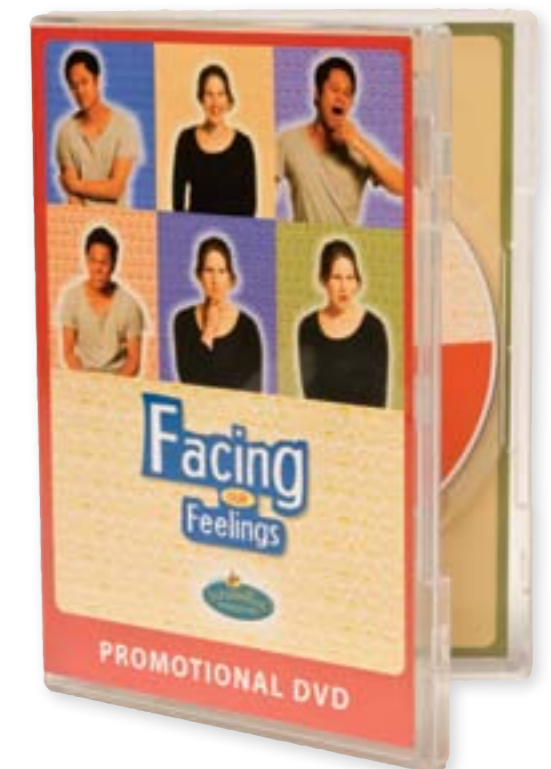

### Project Description


The design for the signage created for Donvale Presbyterian Church was based upon existing signage, along with the architectural style of the building.





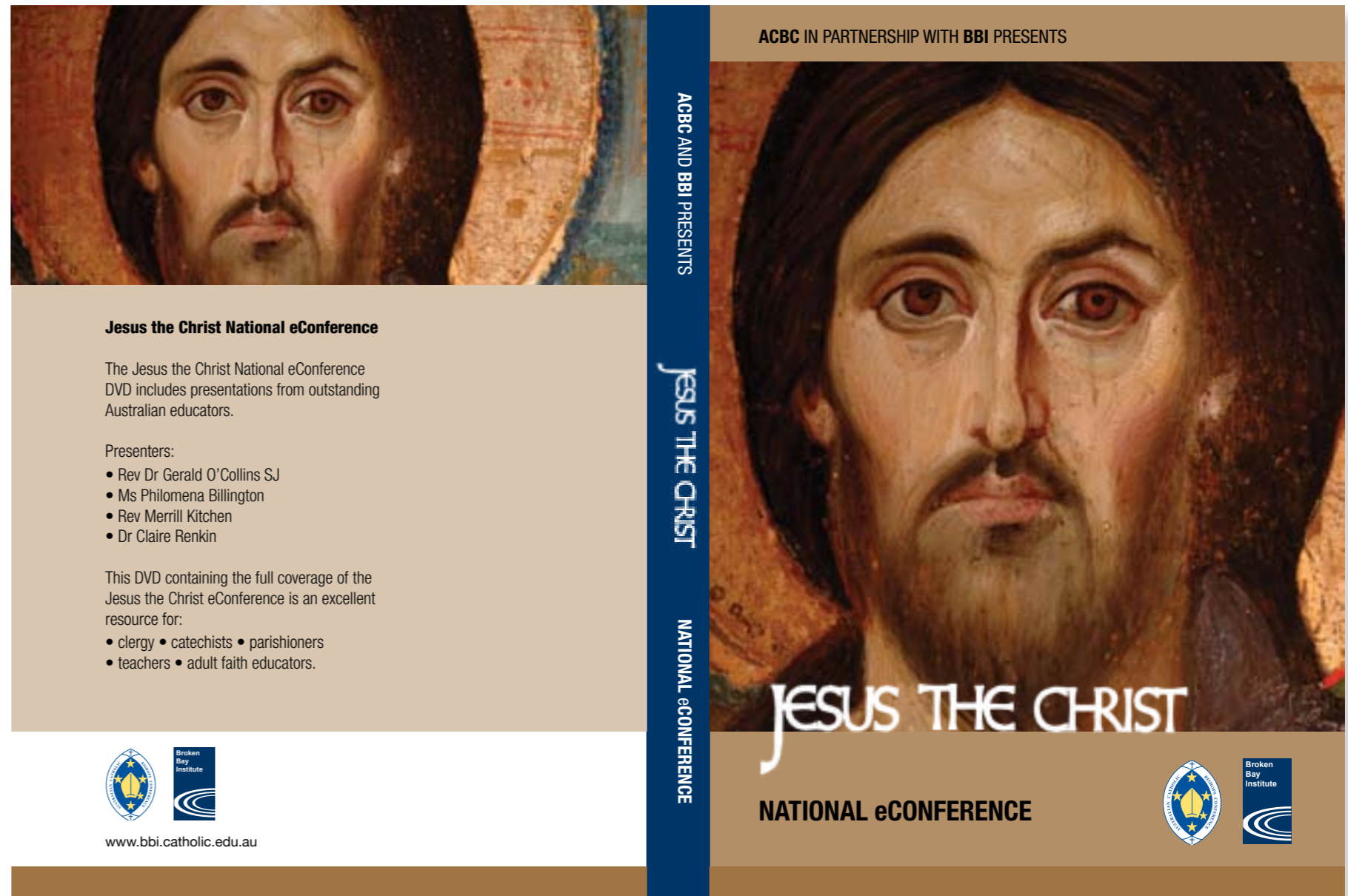
### COLLATERAL FOR TRIVIA NIGHT

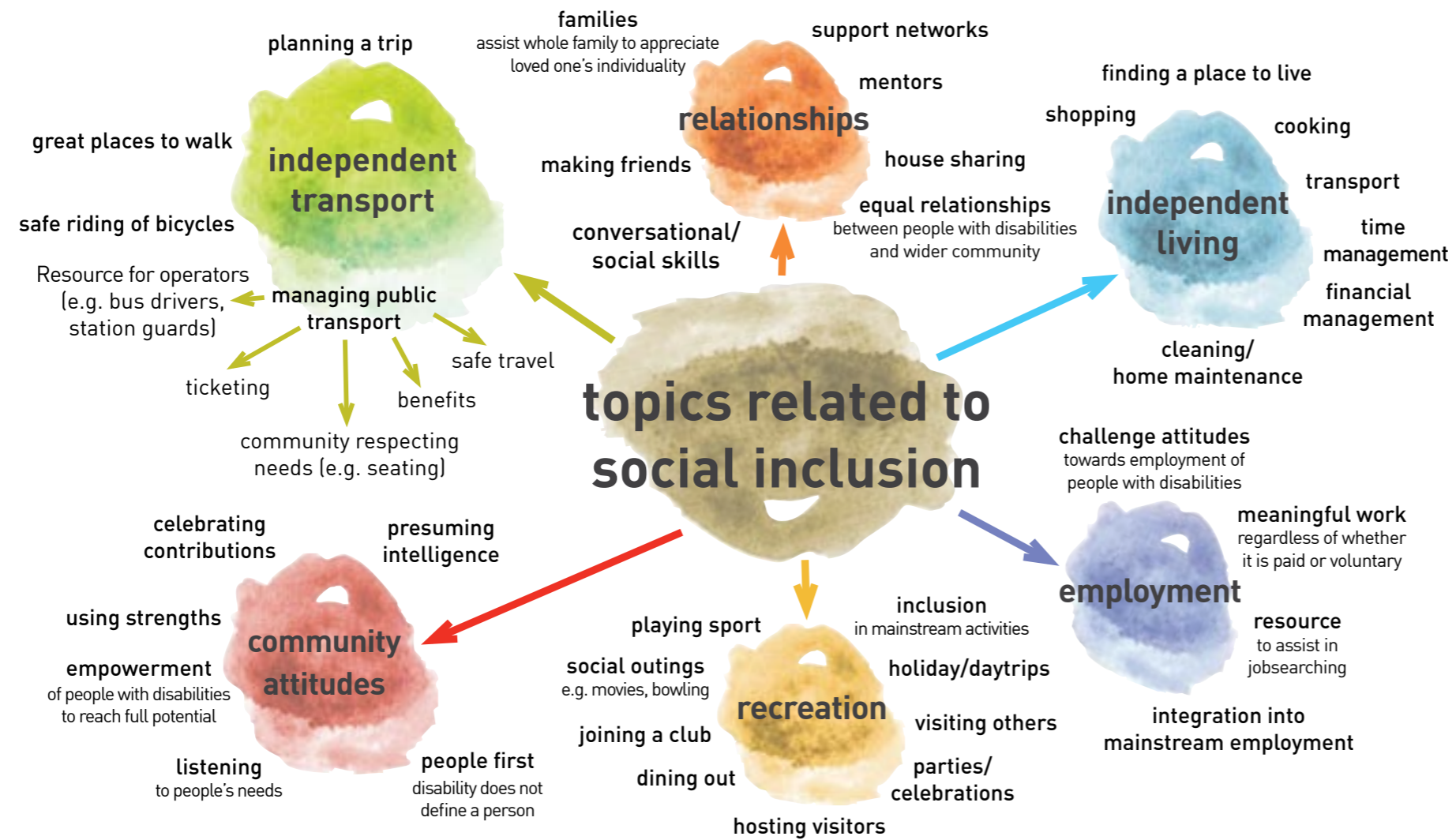
### Project Description

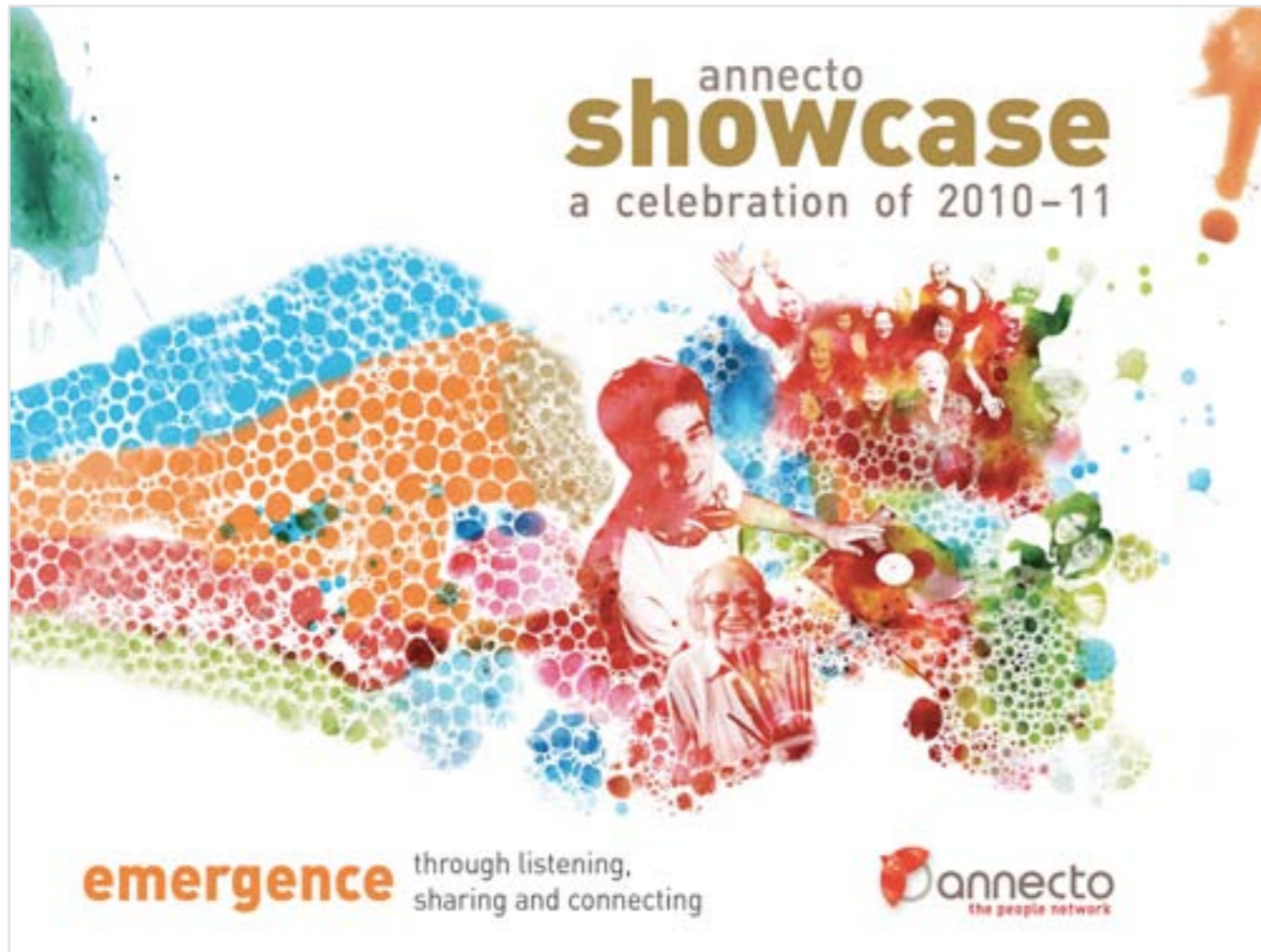

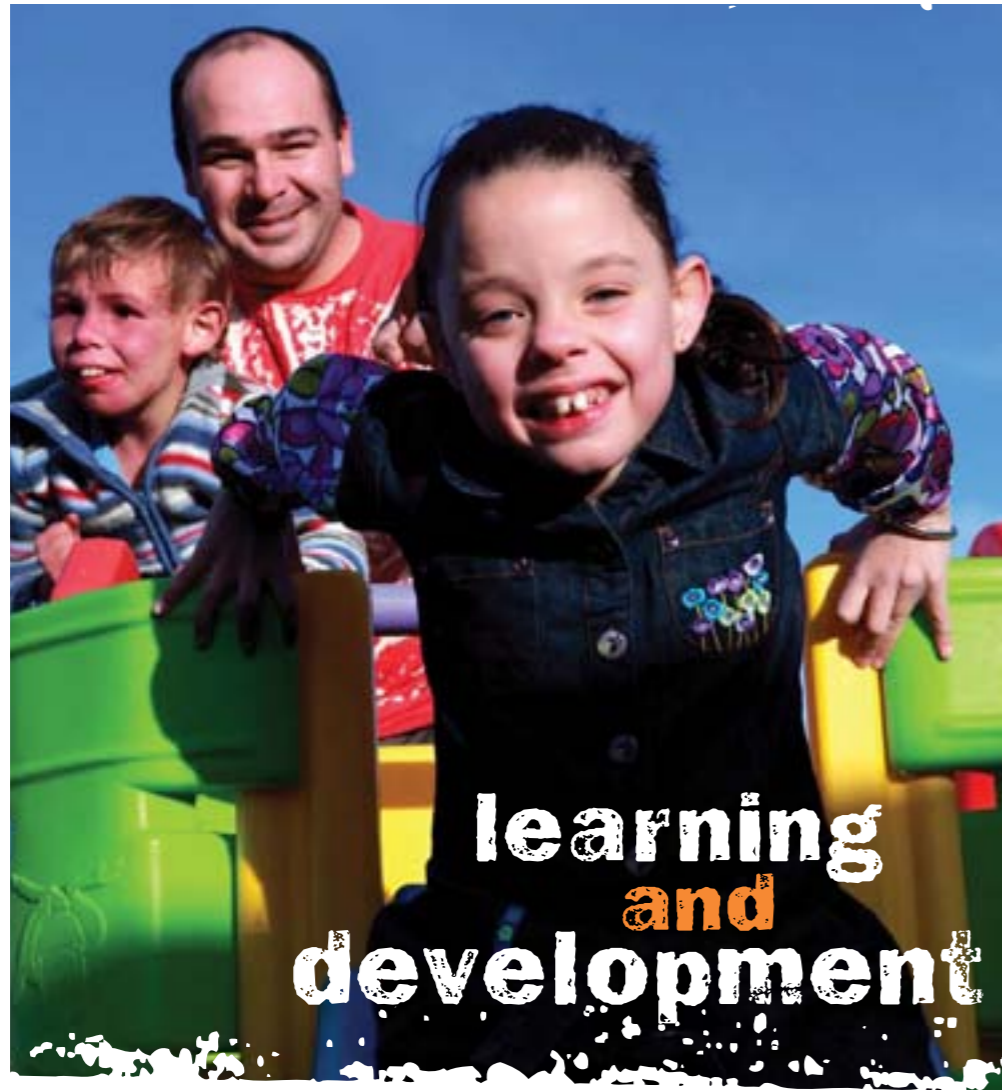
